

CAOT AWARDS

Honorary Associate Award

The Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists will grant Honorary Associate in the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists in accordance with the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists By-Laws. Nominations for Honorary Associate will be considered annually but Honorary Associate will be awarded only when recognition is merited in accordance with stated criteria.

Criteria for selection

Nominations must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Nominees must have demonstrated an outstanding contribution to the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists or to the profession of occupational therapy as defined in the Awards Program.
- 2. Occupational therapists are not eligible for Honorary Associate.
- 3. Nominees must not be a current Board member or employee of the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists.
- 4. Nominees need not be a resident in Canada if the achievements for which they are nominated have relevance to Canadian occupational therapy and they meet the other criteria for the award.
