- 1. Participate in the strategic planning processes for OT Now;
- 2. Critically review OT Now for maintaining currency in the content;
- Propose new or modified policy in order to strengthen the standards and processes of OT Now, in a manner consistent with the policy guidelines set by the CAOT;
- 4. Respond and provide input to the Managing Editor as requested regarding ethical dilemmas arising from submissions to OT Now;
- 5. Serve as short deadline manuscript reviewers when asked;
- 6. Evaluate the work of the OT Now Editorial Board on an annual basis for continuous improvement;
- 7. Participate in the process of selecting Topic Editors;
- 8. Serve as a member of the Appeals Committee in situations where an author appeals the decision of the Managing Editor.
- 9. Have a mandatory CAOT membership.
