



Call for communication

The Centre intégré universitaire de santé et de services sociaux de la Capitale-Nationale is proud to announce that the 9th National Workshop for Driver Rehabilitation Specialists will be held at the **Québec City Convention Center, October 29th, 30th & 31st, 2019.**

This event is an opportunity to share the latest trends in research, practice and training in driver rehabilitation. Many equipment suppliers will attend to present the latest innovations in adaptive equipment and vehicle modifications in the exhibit hall.

Speakers – clinicians, researchers, students or partners – interested in giving a lecture or a poster presentation, running a workshop or conducting a round-table/panel discussion are invited to submit a proposal.

The main topics during this event will be:

- Professional practice: legal and ethical aspects
- Driving ability evaluation (e.g. predictive tests, medication...)
- Specific rehabilitation interventions (training of a person's driving abilities, driving cessation, new drivers with special needs, complex car modification...)
- Clients characteristics and the effect upon the interventions (e.g. Autism spectrum disorder, vision impairment or disability, anxiety, ADHD...)
- New technologies (e.g. technological development, new equipment studies...)

FORMATS - There are different kinds of proposals that can be submitted such as:

- Conference (45 minutes or 60 minutes including time for questions)
- Poster presentation
- Presentation at a kiosk
- Workshop (1h30)
- Round-table discussion (panel) (1h30)

Other interesting propositions may be submitted. Simultaneous translation will be available for some presentations.

All proposals will be analyzed by the scientific committee according to the following criteria:

- Relevance of the topic
- Innovative content and/or information given
- Clarity and quantity of summary
- Clinical outcome

You will be informed of the scientific committee's decision directly by email.
